IMPORTANT NOTICE

F. No. HQ-C1102/9/2025-C-1: The candidates may please refer to the Notice of **Combined Higher Secondary (10+2) Level Examination, 2025 (CHSLE-2025)** published by the Commission on its website on 23.06.2025 and Corrigendum dated 25.03.2026. The Staff Selection Commission conducted the Combined Higher Secondary (10+2) Level Examination (Tier-I), 2025 from 12.11.2025 to 30.11.2025 in the Computer Based Mode. The result of Tier-I was declared on 27.02.2026 for shortlisting the candidates for appearing in Tier-II of CHSLE- 2025 which was held on 10.04.2026 and 22.04.2026.

2. Before the declaration of First Round of Tentative Allocation (FRTA)/ result, Option-cum-Preference for post(s)/ department(s) are required to be submitted by those candidates who have appeared in Tier-II examination. Accordingly, all candidates, who have appeared in Tier-II, are advised to submit their Option-cum-Preference for post(s)/ department(s) for CHSLE-2025 through their respective 'CANDIDATE LOGIN' on the website i.e., **https://ssc.gov.in** wherein facility of submission of Option-cum-Preference for post(s)/ department(s) will be available under My Application Tab, which will remain active during the period from **19.06.2026 (06:00 PM) to 22.06.2026 (06:00 PM)** for the candidates who have appeared in Tier-II examination.

3. Candidates may please note that the Option-cum-Preference can be revised only during the aforesaid period and Option-cum-Preference last submitted by the candidate will be treated as final. **Candidates must ensure that after filling their preference, they must submit the form by clicking the "SUBMIT" button.** Candidates who fail to exercise their Option-cum-Preference during the aforesaid period, shall not be given any further opportunity for submission of their Option-cum-Preference and such candidates will not be considered for inclusion in the FRTA/final selection. Therefore, the candidates who have appeared in Tier-II are required to **mandatorily** exercise their Option-cum-Preference for consideration of their candidature in the FRTA/final selection in CHSLE-2025.

4. PwBD candidates must ensure that they submit preference for only those posts that are identified as suitable for their disabilities. Allocation of posts will be made as per the provisions of the Notice of examination and Corrigendum dated 25.03.2026 on the basis of 'merit-cum-preference of posts'. The candidature of a PwBD candidate will get

cancelled by the User Department concerned if he/ she gets selected for a post that is not identified as suitable for his/ her disabilities.

5. Before exercising their preference of posts, candidates must go through the Notice of Examination and Corrigendum dated 25.03.2026. All candidates are requested to ensure that they fulfill the requisite Physical and Medical Standards for the post before submitting the preference form. The candidature of a candidate may get cancelled by the User Department concerned if he/she gets selected for a post and later on it is found that he/she doesn't meet the requisite Physical and/or Medical Standard of the post. **The posts in Border Roads Organisation, Ministry of Defence are suitable for male candidates only.**

6. Candidates, who do not submit their post preference(s) on the website of the Commission within the stipulated time, will not be considered for any post in the FRTA/Final Result. Such candidates shall not be provided with another opportunity to exercise preference for posts and will be solely responsible for the same. Any grievance received in this regard in any form like Post, Fax, Email, by hand, etc. shall not be entertained by the Commission and will be summarily rejected.
